Neighbourhood Support Child Care Project

Service Objective

The Neighbourhood Support Child Care Project (NSCCP) aims to provide needy parents with a flexible form of day child care service at the neighbourhood level and, at the same time, to foster mutual help and care in the community. It also serves as a safety net to provide a safe venue for children whose parents/ carers have to stay away from home on occasions due to various personal commitments or sudden engagement, and to minimise the risk of children being left unattended.

Target Beneficiaries

The service target of NSCCP is primarily for newborn to pre-primary school children whose parents are (a) either working long, unstable or unconventional hours, having emergency child care needs, or facing situations beyond their control so that ad-hoc child care service is required; (b) lacking in personal support network for child care assistance; and (c) having financial or social hardship in securing care by their own means. It also serves primary school children with ad-hoc or emergency care needs.

Service Components

- 1. Home-based child care service: provides child care service for (a) newborn to pre-primary school children, and (b) primary school children with ad-hoc or emergency care needs at the child carers' own residence or a suitable place as approved by the service operator.
- 2. Centre-based care group: offers child care service to children from 3 years old to primary school level with ad-hoc or emergency care needs at the service centre of the service operator.

Operating Hours

- 3. Home-based child care service: 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.
- 4. Centre-based care group: At least three sessions (each session lasts at least three consecutive full hours) on weekdays with normal operating hours from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. and at least four sessions (each session lasts at least two consecutive full hours) on Saturdays/Sundays (except public holidays)

Fees

- 1. Home-based child care service: \$28 per hour
- 2. Centre-based care group: \$20 per hour

Service users with social needs and financial hardship may approach service operators for fee waiving application.

Service Hotline

A project-based service hotline with a designated telephone number will be in operation from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. on weekdays and during the operation hours of CCG on Saturdays or Sundays (except public holidays) to handle enquiries for service information and child care service requests. Outside the operating hours, needy families under special circumstances requiring urgent child care service may contact SWD Hotline on 2343 2255 for assistance.
